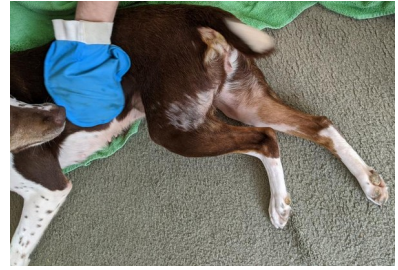
Tilly loves to cuddle after a long day of school work, playing, jumping to get butterflies, go after garden snakes, play with her toys, etc. She is a lap dog.

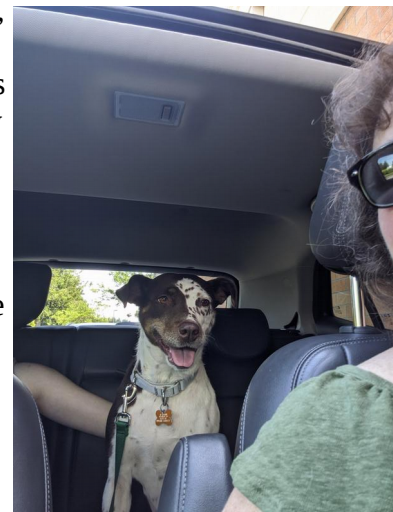

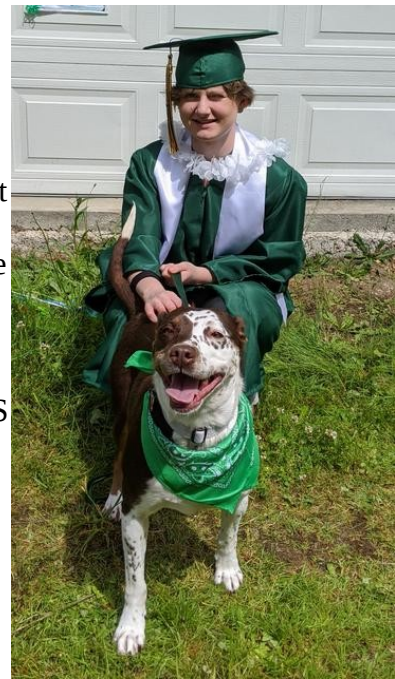

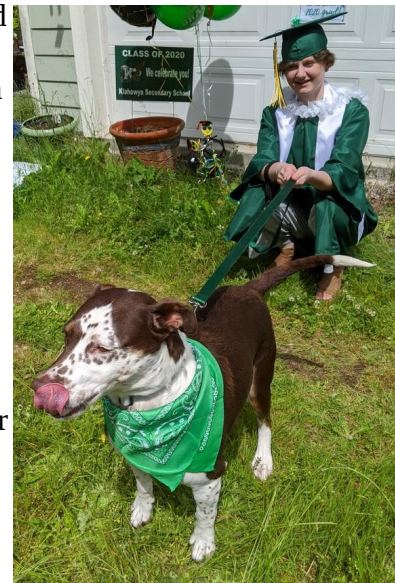
